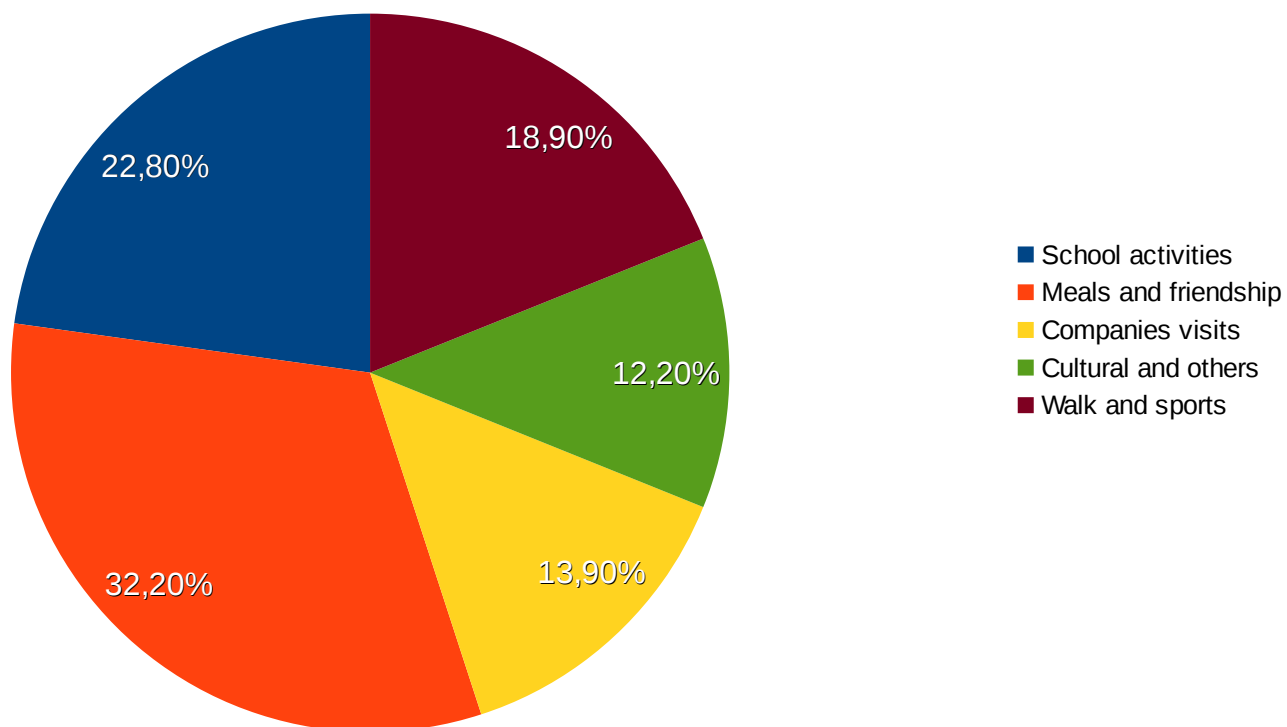

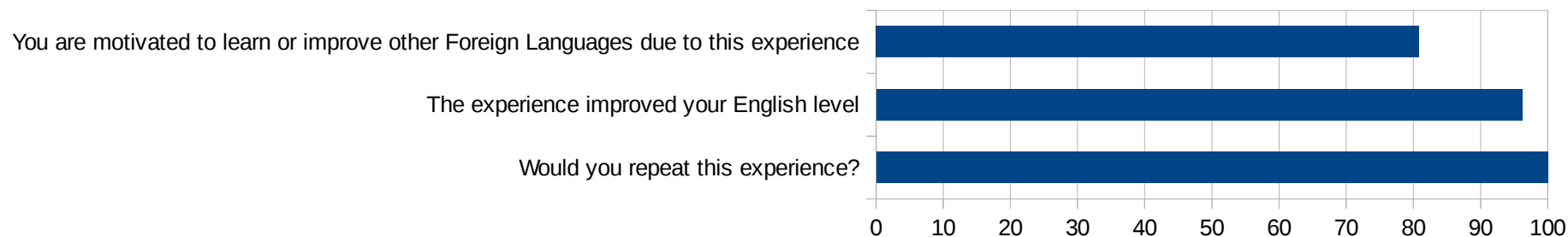

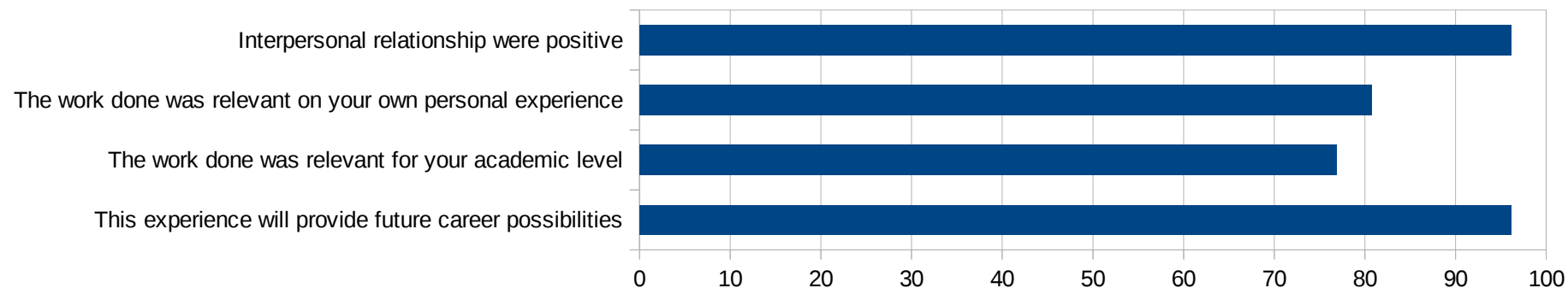
2.1.- About english (% of students participants)

Students Opinion : International



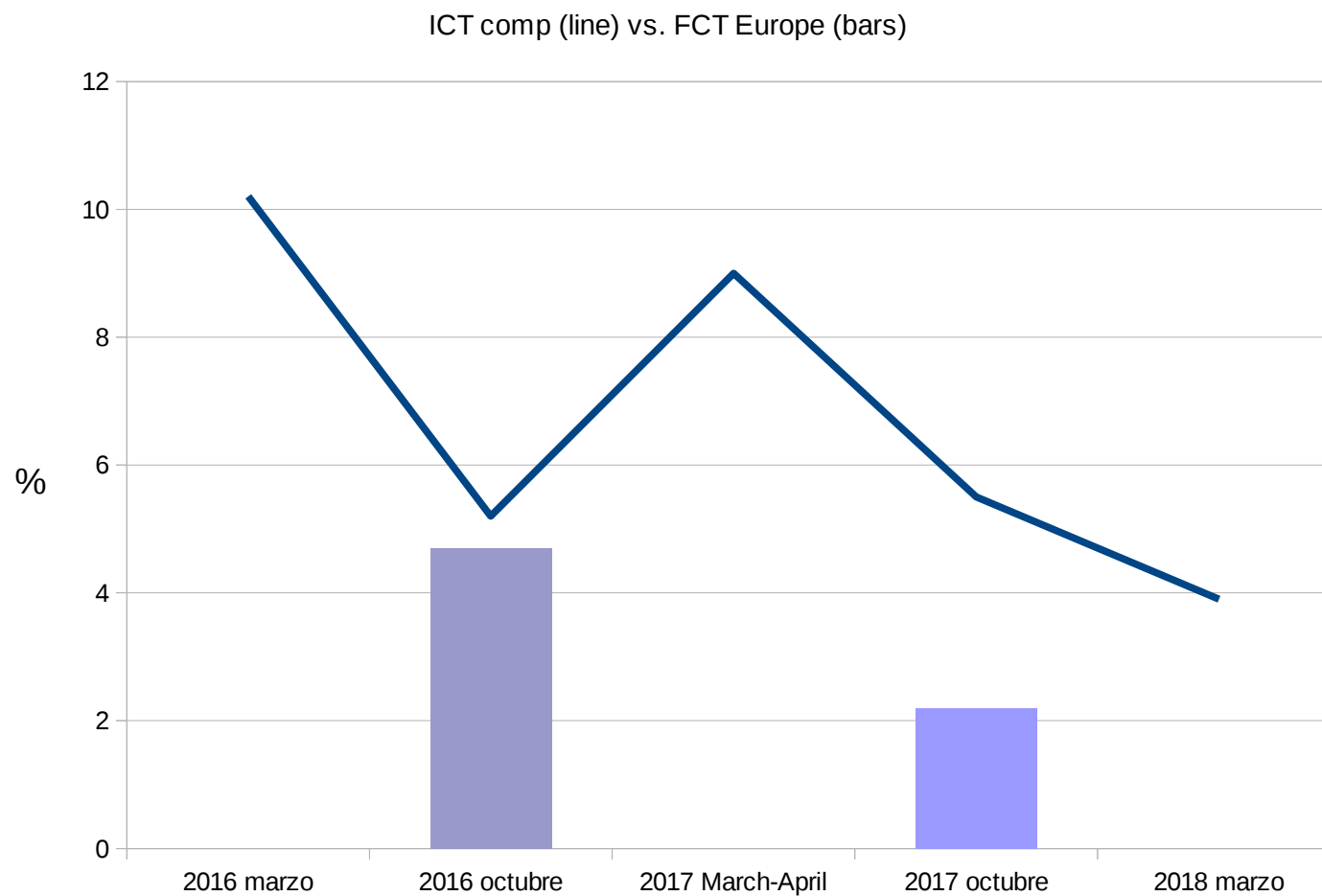
2.2.- About personal and professional items (% of students participants)

4.- Conclusions:

4.1.- About Spanish students Erasmus+ participation.

- Our students (15 - 19 yo) can enroll in both Erasmus+ as individuals (FCT) or group projects. They prefer group projects.

4.2.- About international students satisfaction on Erasmus+ project participation. Related to Alcoi LTT activities: October 2016.

- Students considered their participation as a good experience: all participants 100% declare they would like to repeat.
- Not everybody think Erasmus+ activities represent a motivation for learning foreign languages → 20% against 80%.
- On the other hand, the great majority (96%) expressed that their Erasmus+ experience improved their English level.
- For approx. 25% students is not relevant their work in ICT competitions for their academic level.
- Majority (96%) of participants students consider Erasmus+ ICT competitions experience beneficial for both interpersonal relationship and future career possibilities.
